WHEREAS, McKinney's character has been strengthened and enhanced by citizens who maintain and honor cultural values and customs brought from other lands; and Asian Pacific Americans have long been part of that tradition; and

WHEREAS, today Asian Americans have made important contributions to our City and our nation in government, business, education, science, the arts, and other fields, and are recognized for their hard work and success; and

WHEREAS, during Asian American and Pacific Islander (AAPI) Heritage Month, we celebrate the accomplishments of Asian Americans, Native Hawaiians, and Pacific Islanders, and we reflect on the many ways they have enriched our Nation; and

we encourage our citizens to join in celebrating the collective accomplishments of the heterogeneous communities that comprise Asian Pacific American Cultures in McKinney and throughout the Dallas – Fort Worth Metroplex.
